You are being contacted because the university has been notified that there was a horrible tragedy where a balcony collapsed at 2020 Kittredge St. We are reaching out to any student who we have on record as living at that address. If you are a student who is currently residing at 2020 Kittredge St. and have been affected by this incident, the university has identified resources below that can be of assistance to you.

- **Financial Assistance:**
