EMBARGO EXTENSION PETITION FORM

Background:

Following an initial two-year embargo period, graduates may petition the Graduate Division to postpone full public release of a dissertation for an additional two years. Permission will be granted only for specific reasons, such as work subject to patent applications, or the graduate's intention to publish from the dissertation with a publisher who will not consider manuscripts derived from dissertations that have been made available online. (Please note that most publishers do *not* have those types of restrictive pre-publication policies.)

This Embargo Extension Petition Form applies only to the copy of your dissertation that will be preserved in the UC's eScholarship repository. It is your responsibility to separately request an embargo renewal from ProQuest/UMI to embargo the copy to be made available through ProQuest.

Procedure:

Please submit a signed copy of this form via PDF attachment to lemontt@berkeley.edu. Please also attach to your e-mail transmission all documentation you wish to be considered in support of your petition—such as correspondence from your publisher and your Dissertation Chair (or if unavailable, the current Department Chair) in support of an embargo extension.

Be sure to submit this form request with sufficient time (at least three months) prior to the expiration of your current embargo to ensure adequate processing time prior to your dissertation's scheduled release. If a renewal request is submitted less than three months from when an existing embargo is set to expire, we cannot guarantee that it will be processed and granted in time to preclude your dissertation from being made publicly available.

If this Embargo Extension Petition is granted, it will run for one or two years (depending on the request made below) from the date on which your previous embargo was set to expire.
